
### Our Team



### (First Notice)

The Annual General Meeting of the Newfoundland-Labrador Federation of Co-operatives (NLFC) will take place on Saturday, June 22nd, 2024, at the Sheraton Hotel Newfoundland. Registration will commence on Saturday morning at 8:00 am. The meeting will begin at 4:00 pm.

### **Delegates & Voting Provileges**

All member co-ops and credit unions are entitled to appoint two (2) voting delegates for the AGM. There is no limit on the number of non-voting delegates that may attend. Voting privileges at the AGM require that members have remitted their 2023/2024 membership fees, except in cases where adjustments have been approved by the NLFC board of directors. Members who are unable to pay their fees should contact the NLFC office and request an adjustment.

#### **NLFC Board Elections**

There are four (4) positions to be filled this year, three 3-year terms, and one 1-year term. Those interested in running for election should complete the <u>Candidate Information Kit</u> and return to the NLFC office for distribution. Nominations will be accepted at any time prior to the elections on Saturday, June 22nd.

#### **Resolutions**

Resolutions should be submitted to the NLFC office using the enclosed form. Deadline for inclusion in the delegate package is June 10th. Submissions of resolutions is permitted at the AGM, but they should be photocopied by the presenter to facilitate distribution.

### **Registration and Fee**

A meeting registration form is attached and should be completed and forwarded by email prior to the meeting. There is no registration fee for the AGM portion of NLFC 75 and members may attend for free from 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm. An Event Pass is \$200, an additional Banquet Ticket for guests not attending the AGM is \$100, and the Session Ticket is \$25.

Rooms have been reserved at the Sheraton Hotel Newfoundland. Accommodations are \$239 plus tax, per night. We urge you to book your room/s as early as possible to ensure availability.

This accolade is designed to celebrate the selfless dedication of volunteers whose tireless work has significantly impacted the co-operative sector in Newfoundland & Labrador. From fostering community engagement to spearheading impactful projects, the NLFC, Tom Best Volunteer of the Year Award aims to spotlight those individuals whose volunteerism exemplifies the true spirit of co-operation. This award not only acknowledges the invaluable contributions of these dedicated volunteers but also serves as an inspiration to others, encouraging a culture of giving back and active involvement in co-operative initiatives.



Tom Best, 36 year President for the Petty Harbour Fishermen's Coop, was a fiercely proud inshore fish harvester who dedicated his life's work to advocating for sustainable fisheries and communities.

### Star Co-operator of the Year

The Star Co-operator of the Year award recognizes the contributions of a co-op member or professional who personifies the co-operative principles and has gone above and beyond to help further the mission of their co-op/credit union in Newfoundland & Labrador during the past year.
